



Construction Update

Cambridge-Johnson STP 2925(1)

[Cambridge-Johnson VT 15 Resurfacing Project]

DATE: Friday, May 9, 2025

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: From Monday, May 12, through Friday, May 16, between 6 a.m. and 7 p.m., there will be up to three traffic control packages with alternating one-way traffic on Vermont Route 15 (VT 15) between Park Street in Johnson and the VT 15/ VT 108 junction in Cambridge.

Starting Wednesday, May 14, at 7 p.m., the Park & Ride on VT 15 located just east of the VT 15/ VT 108 roundabout in Cambridge will be closed to the public 24/7 to allow for construction. A follow-up notice will be issued when it reopens.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Throughout the week, crews will install new roadway signs and delineation posts on VT 15. They will also construct concrete sloped ramps for the Lamoille Valley Rail Trail crossing on VT 15 near Hillcrest Drive. In addition, culvert work will take place on VT 15 in Cambridge. On Thursday and Friday, crews are expected to begin excavation of the Park & Ride on VT 15 just east of the VT 15/ VT 108 roundabout in Cambridge.

LOCATION: Vermont Route 15 from the VT 15/ VT 108 junction in Cambridge, continuing 9.1 miles to a point east of the VT 100C intersection in the Village of Johnson.
